DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

▶ Opening Question

- How was money handled or mishandled in your life as a child?

▶ Reading

- Take a moment for individuals to flip through the Week Six reading. What most captured your attention? Why?
- Read aloud the first paragraph under the heading “Stewards” (page 139). Directly following this paragraph is the question, “We’re resistant to this. Why?” Are you resistant to the idea of stewardship. Why or why not?

▶ Morph Me

- As a group, read aloud the money personality descriptions on pages 151-155. Have each person who assessed with a particular personality (top 1 or 2) read what they wrote when they put the description in their own words.
- What internal and external commitments did you make in Stage Three (page 157)?

▶ Conversations with God

- Read together Deuteronomy 8:17-18, one of this week’s memory verses. How does this verse challenge or encourage your thinking?
- What is one thing that especially got your attention in Acts 6–12?
